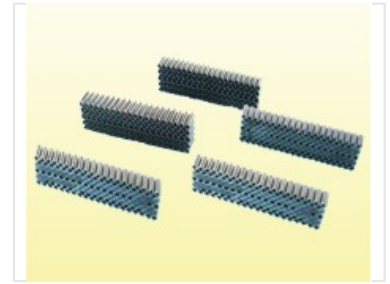


Corrugated Wood Nails
