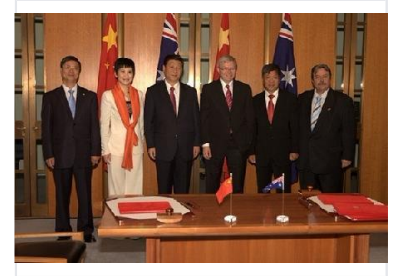


Coal Mine Development Project

Project Overview

Coal Mine Development Project

This large-scale mining development involves the construction of a comprehensive coal extraction facility with an annual production capacity of 40 million tonnes. The project scope encompasses the mine site itself, 490 kilometers of dedicated railway infrastructure, and a two-berth export terminal at Abbot Point. Designed to integrate extraction with logistics, this development represents a significant capital investment aimed at streamlining the export supply chain.
