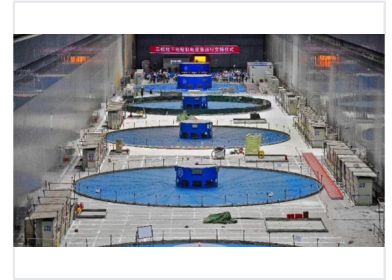


Hydropower Station Project
