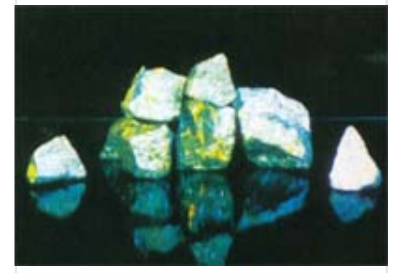


# Molybdenum-Iron Alloy Ore
